

## Viol consort **Les Escapades**

Inspired by the intriguing sound of the viola da gamba, the musicians Barbara Pfeifer, Sabine Kreuzberger, Adina Scheyhing and Franziska Finckh founded the viol consort **Les Escapades** in 2000.

The name refers to intrigues or liaisons and gives the flavour of the ensemble's programmes which create space for a new listening experience.

Besides their concerts as a viol quartet they perform frequently with other instrumentalists, dancers, actors and singers, for example with Miriam Feuersinger, soprano from Austria and winner of the „Echo-Klassik“ 2014.

**Les Escapades** has become well-known by playing concerts in the European area, so, for example, at the Festival for Early Music, Daroca/Spain, the SEMF-Stockholm Early Music Festival) and also by numerous CD recordings.
